Gina Fedock, PhD, MSW, is an assistant professor at the University of Chicago School of Social Service Administration. She received her doctorate degree from Michigan State University. Her clinical practice and primary research areas focus on intervention development, implementation, and assessment of outcomes to improve women's mental health, both in the community and while incarcerated.

Dr. Fedock's foundation is in trauma-informed, evidence-based, best practices for women involved in the criminal justice system. She continues to do research on strategies for improving women's outcomes by implementing gender-responsive and trauma-informed practices and policies. Her specific ongoing interests include prevention-focused interventions for women under community supervision, addressing and lessening racial disparities for incarcerated women, and intervention development for women with life sentences. Dr. Fedock is committed in her research and practice to the intersections of criminal justice, mental and physical health, trauma and violence, and human rights.

Dr. Fedock has assisted in implementing, facilitating, and testing Dr. Stephanie Covington's violence-prevention intervention for women, *Beyond Violence*, and has provided training in delivering gender-responsive programming to correctional, clinical, and academic professionals in the United States and abroad.
